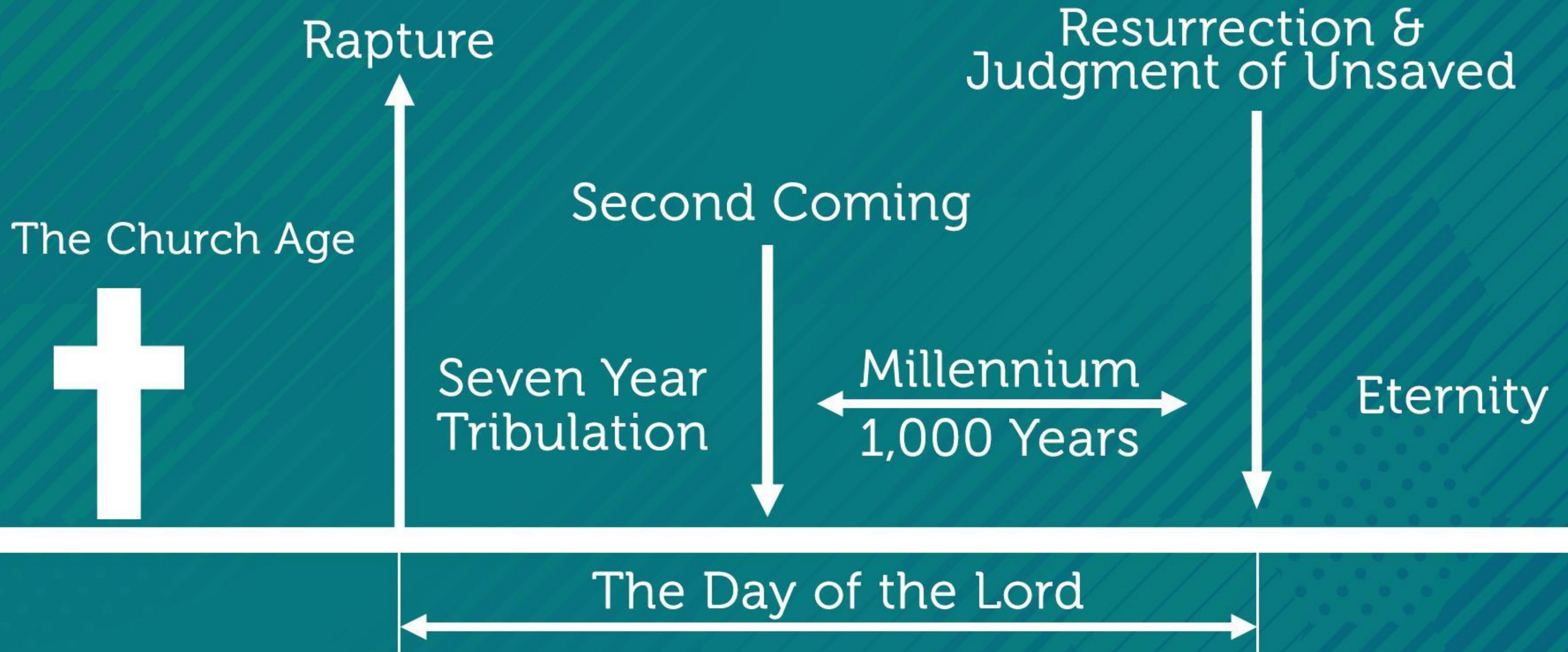

PRE-TRIBULATIONAL RETURN



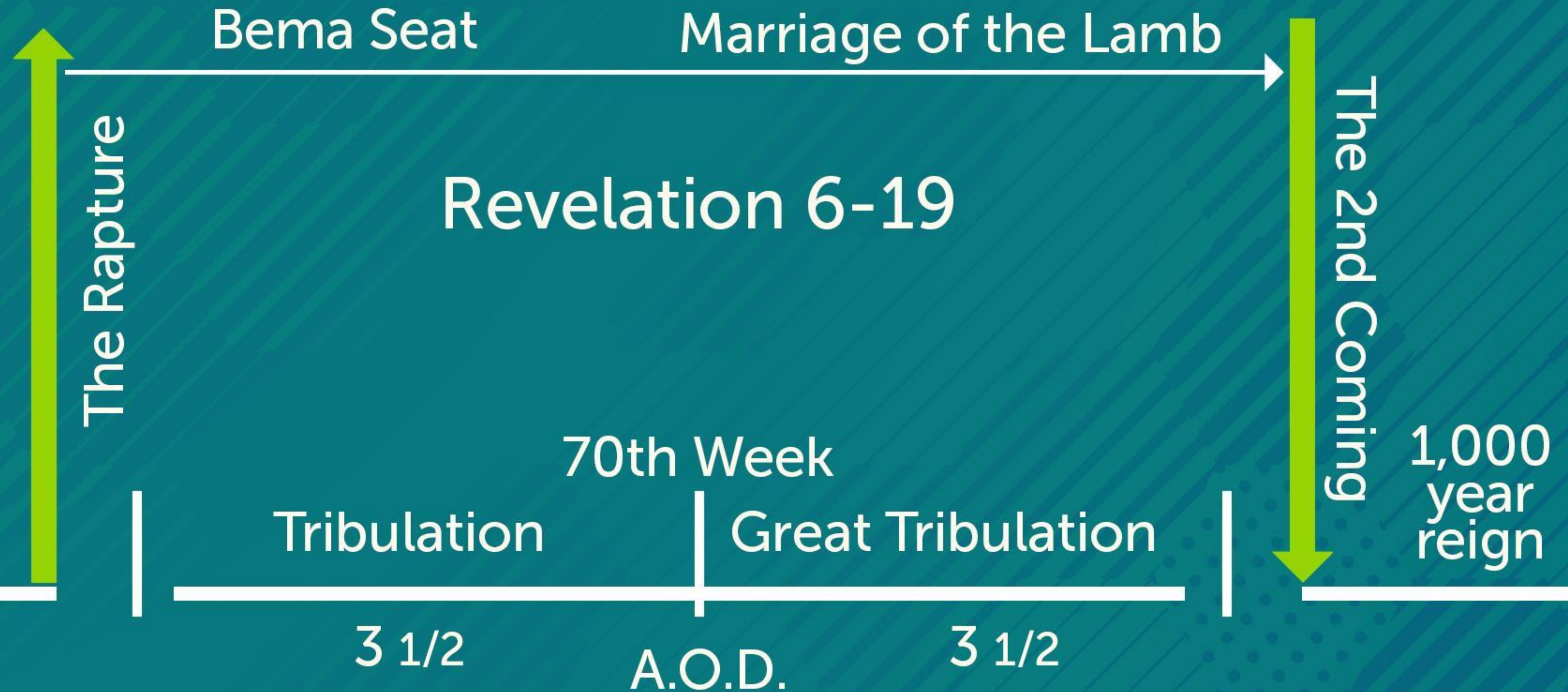

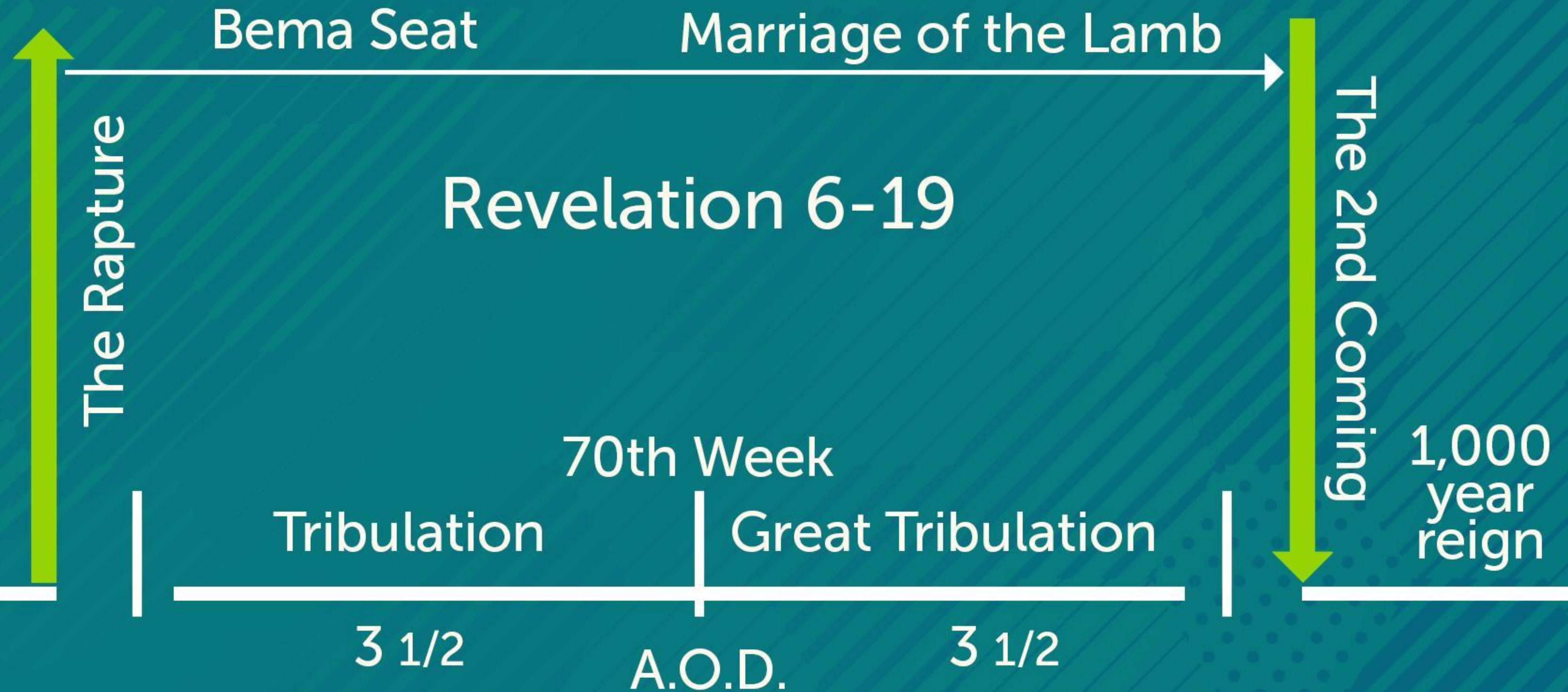
