Prophecies Related to the Temple Mount


- 1. Jews would return in unbelief to Jerusalem to reclaim their heritage and destiny (Ezekiel 36:24; Romans 11:27).

- 4. Jerusalem would again be threatened by the Gentile nations (Ezekiel 38-39; Zechariah 12:2; 14:2).






Could the Rebuilding of the Third Temple Be a Sign That the Rapture is Closer?

The recent developments in Jerusalem regarding plans to rebuild the Third Temple have reignited debates among religious scholars, historians, and global watchers. This sacred site, Mount Moriah—housing both the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock—has a complex history of division and contention between the Jewish and Muslim faiths (Dena Takruri, 2022; Henry, 2022). Many now ask whether the strategic division of this holy land, instigated by powerful political forces and secret societies, was a calculated move to ignite a Third World War that would usher in a New World Order. The suggestion that the rebuilding of the Third Temple and related escalating conflicts could signal the approaching rapture is not unfounded, especially as we examine the prophetic links, historical context, and intentions of influential global forces.









WAR FOR THE TEMPLE MOUNT!

In a video taken from the courtyards of the mosque, the far-right minister said the Jerusalem site "belongs only to the state of Israel".











Terror army's military spokesman gives startling explanation in rare speech

ISRAEL – While political experts worldwide pontificate on the war in Gaza, most have overlooked Hamas' explicitly stated reason for its Oct. 7 attacks on Israel, revealed on Day 100 of the war.

It is said that this is where the world began—and perhaps where it will end.

The true epicenter of the war in the Holy Land is not the devastated Gaza Strip, under Israeli assault since Hamas bloody raid last October sparked the region's deadliest conflict in decades. Robes have been woven and utensils assembled to Biblical specifications for ceremonies at the planned temple.

Israel Defense Minister Naftali Bennett last Wednesday insisted that these are the days of the Third Temple, and that the modern State of Israel is very much a part of the prophesied global redemption.

Speaking at a yeshiva (Jewish seminary) in the north of Israel ahead of next month's election, Bennett explained why he was trying to keep another religious right-wing politician out of the Knesset.

According to Bennett, the controversial Itamar Ben Gvir, like many Orthodox Jews, fails to recognize the biblical and prophetic significance and authority of the <u>State of Israel</u> and its institutions.

Bennett went on to explain that despite its long history, Israel has only managed to rule as a unified nation in this land for two very short periods, and that because of internal divisions and the failure to submit to a central authority.

"We have had a state twice where we ruled as a united people. The first time it only lasted 80 years – King David 40, then King Solomon 40. After that, we separated," said Bennett. Likewise, the Second Temple was destroyed because everyone "followed their own rules," the defense minister said, before exclaiming, "We need to understand the big picture. Today we are in the time of the Third Temple!"

Yes, the State of Israel is a liberal, largely-secular democracy. And yet, faith in the Bible and belief in the prophecies it contains regarding this nation continue to play a major role in Israeli politics.


