Carl Broggi



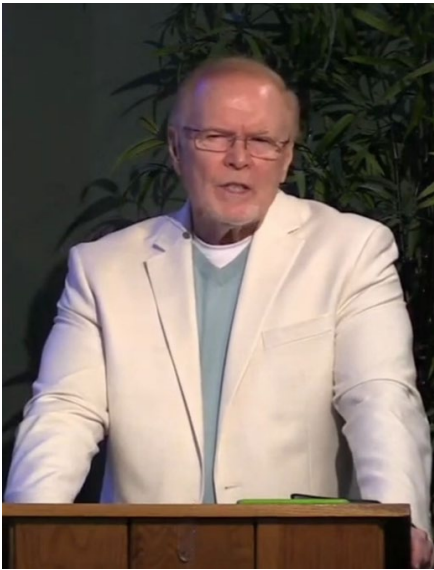
